2 Details of Applications open for consultation

Dolphin Quay is located towards the Eastern side of Emsworth and has historically acted as a small, independent boat repair yard servicing Chichester Harbour. In 2012 boat repair operators relocated elsewhere and the site has sat dormant since. In recent years the site has been badly flooded which has demonstrated the limited usefulness of the accommodation and has hampered marketing of the site as a boat yard. In 2018, planning permission was approved for the conversion of the site, with a component being the replacement of the failing quay wall, which under the Environment Agencies consultation response is also required to conform to the Flood Protection levels and function.

The preferred design calls for a new sheet pile wall to be driven immediately landward of the existing wall position and once it is complete and sealed any material seaward of the new wall will be removed and disposed of to land. This will remove the failing existing quay wall and will create a slight increase in the intertidal area adjacent to the site.

The new seawall will be installed above MHW in all but one position, where it crosses the old slipway and therefore this construction activity is within the Marine Licensing remit for approximately 5 metres.

This application seeks a Marine Licence to permit the installation of approximately 5m of the Quay Wall as detailed, along with the removal of the existing quay wall, which is visibly assessed as stacked wooden sleepers supported by vertical I beams, along with any material between the two walls.

Selsey Beach Management Plan

The project: The works involve the importation of up to 6,000m³/yr. of pre-graded shingle beach material. The material is to be deposited and spread at Selsey West Beach over 15 groyne bays (groynes B7-W8). The material source will be an offshore licensed aggregate extraction site.

The aim of the project is to improve the standard of coastal protection, slow down the rate of foreshore erosion, reduce overtopping of the seawall and reduce exposure of the seawall.
